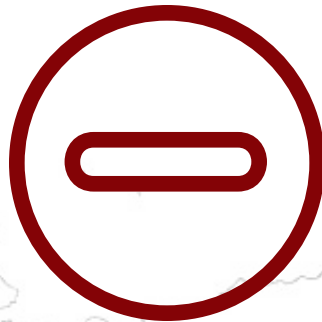

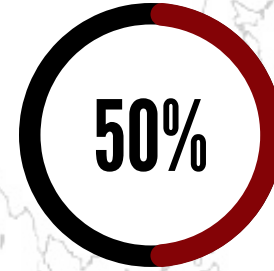

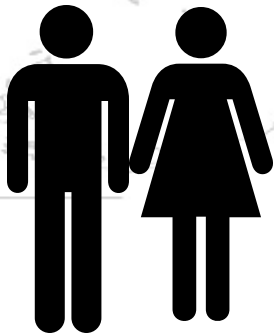

BACKGROUND OF THE SITUATION



The Syrian crisis is in its **7th** year.

Around **13.5** million people are in need of humanitarian assistance.

In Jordan, **660,582** are registered as refugees

Of those, **66%** are children&youth

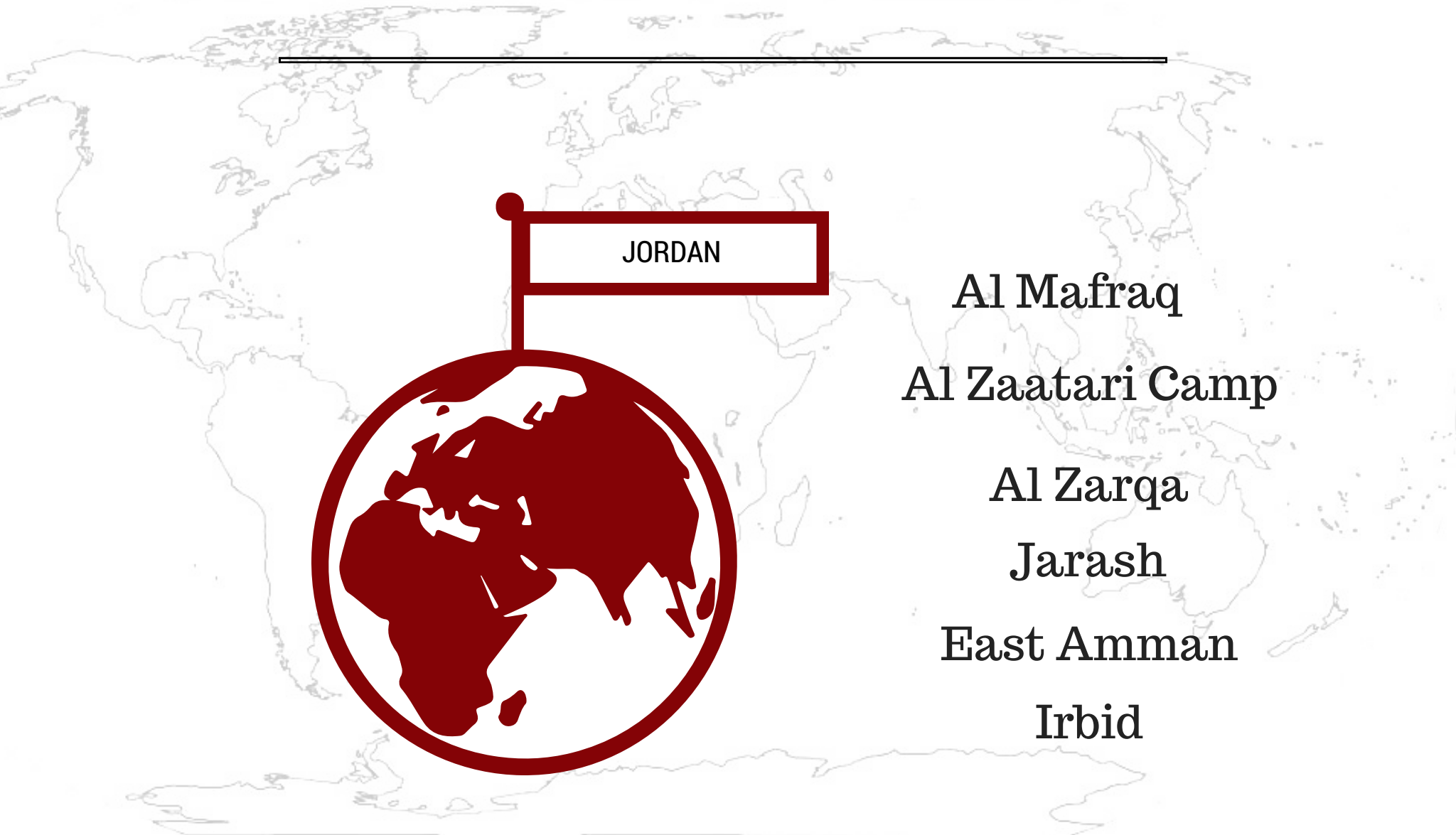

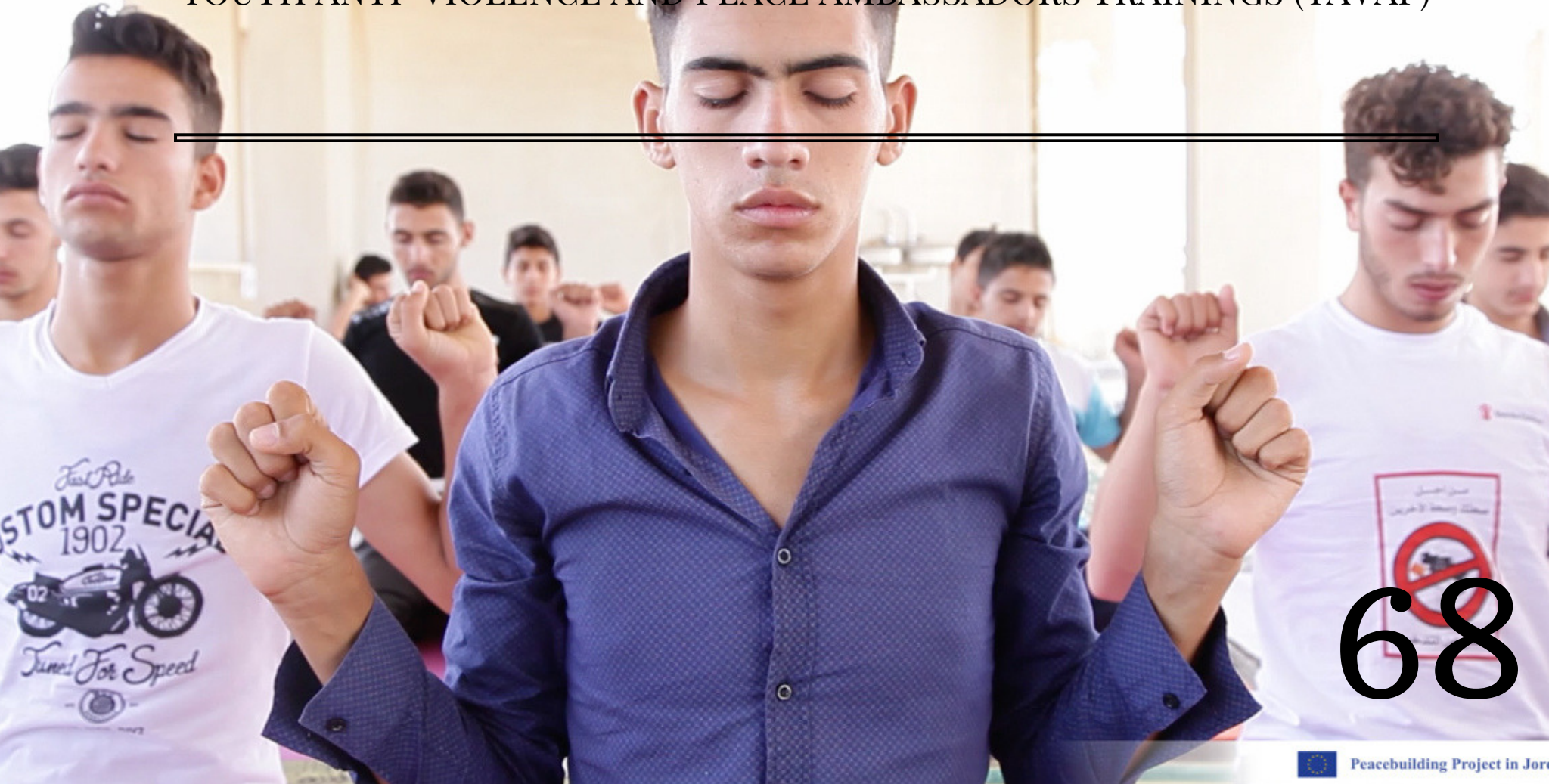

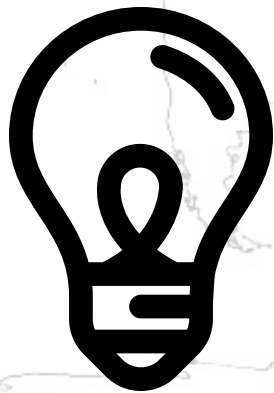
